Commentary

World Growth in virus infection slowed down to 30.32%, Mortality Rate increased to 6.87%, critical case down to 2.43% & Recovery rate Increased to 25.7%

For world economic recovery, it is important USA need to come out fast,..... Further the effect on India, Africa and now South America will determine the pain 🛭 USA cases growth reduced to 38%, mortality rate increased, critical cases falling/Recovery rate increasing

India cases grew 91% but mortality rates fallen/Recovery Cases improved slightly (Data will be an issue like China)

A Countries who are on the path of winning the war on COVID 19: Those Countries where "Recovery To Active Cases more than 100% and Reovery to Total Cases more than 50%" = 44 (Last week 23) count -- More than 100% jump

- -- 33 countries notably China, Greenland, Iceland, Iraq, Thailand, Jordan, Brunei, Senegal, Venezuela have no cases of death in the last one week
- -- 11 Countries notably Iran, Germany, Switzerland, Denmark, Australia, Soth Korea and Austria still have cases of death occuring/reoccurence
- B Countries having less than 100 active cases: 87 (last week 80 Countries mostly small) This shows virus containment increasing East Africa still doing well Uganda/Burundi/Rwanda/Mozambique/Zambia/Ethiopia (Need to watch for two weeks)
- C Most Affected countries with more than 10% motality Rate: Italy, Spain, UK, France, Belgium, Netherlands Sweden, Algeria(with significant poupulations over 60 Years +))
