↑ World Growth in virus infection down to 19%, Mortality Rate increased to 7%, critical case down to 1.4% & Recovery rate Increased to 22.3%

New Hotspot with >50% weekly growth rate: 17 countries (Brasil/Bangladesh/Belarus/Russia/Mexico/Equador/Peru/Pakistan) (LW - 14 countries) Watch Next week

Still Europe is main contributor at present followed by North America (mainly USA), South America and Africa is the new epicenter

↑ USA cases growth reduced to 20%(LW 30%), mortality rate increased to 5.8%, critical cases falling 1.47%(LW 2%) /Recovery rate increasing 15%(LW12%)

↑ India cases grew 52% (LW 58%) but mortality rates flat at 3.2%/Recovery Cases improved by 80% (Data will be an issue like China)

A Countries who are on the path of winning the war on COVID 19 : Those Countries where "Recovery To Active Cases more than 100%

and Reovery to Total Cases more than 50%" = 88(Last week 63) countries -- 40% Improved representing 26% of Infected

-- 49 countries (LW 35) notably China, Greenland, Iceland, Jordan, Brunei, Bahrain, Sri Lanka, Guinea, Hongkong have no cases of death in the last one week

-- 39 Countries notably Iran, Germany, Switzerland, Denmark, Australia, South Korea, Austria, Iraq, Thailand, still have cases of death occurring/reoccurrence

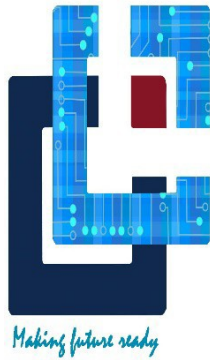
B Countries having less than 100 active cases : 89 (last week 82 Countries mostly small) This shows virus containment fluctuating
